SUBMISSION OF MANUSCRIPTS:

Research papers are invited on above mentioned thematic areas. Contributors are to submit their articles electronically using the format of the Journal of AgriSearch. For details, prospective authors may consult also www.journals.ias.ac.in/journals/for_authors/. Abstract should be limited to 200 words. The papers will be reviewed by double blind peer review system to be published in the Journal of AgriSearch, if found suitable. For respective short listed articles, considered for publication in the journal, all the authors must be members of the society. One author may be co-author of other submission but cannot represent more than one submission. Authors should indicate one or more of the above listed themes that best describe the topic of their contribution, as well as their preference (if any) with respect to mode of presentation (i.e. Oral / Poster). However, final decision with respect to presentation is vested with the Editorial Board/Technical Committee. Similar review process will be binding for both the oral and poster presentations. The program committee will make every effort to satisfy these preferences. Best papers will be awarded to the National Conference. Abstracts of the accepted submission will be published in the book of Abstracts/Source of the Conference.

CALL FOR ABSTRACT

Abstract should be submitted in English and the content of the abstract should be clear, concise and should contain a short introduction, objectives, methods, results and conclusions. The abstract should not exceed 200-400 words (approximately one typed page) with spaces 1.5 in Times New Roman, font size 12, and should include title, authors with presenter name underlined, one email address along with telephone number, fax and mobile number. It should be submitted as an attached MS Word file to e-mail: abstract2016@gmail.com and/or jass.org.in@gmail.com.

Poster presentation:

Poster (X1.2m) should include Title, Name and address of the Author(s), Short introduction, materials and Methods, results and Conclusions.
